Debit or credit card information can also be entered on the back of the pay stub and submitted by mail.

All City of Newport public meetings starting March 17, 2020 will be cancelled until further notice.

The City of Newport will continue to closely monitor the situation and evaluate additional measures to support and protect our citizens and employees as the need arises.
